**TABLE OF FEES AND OTHER CHARGES WITH EFFECT FROM 1 AUGUST 2016**

The undermentioned scale of fees and other charges were adopted by the Council on the 13 of July 2016 and are pursuant to Clause 15 (1) of the Local Authorities Cemeteries Order, 1977, a Statutory Instrument issued by the Secretary of State for the Environment under Section 214 (3) of the Local Government Act, 1972.

1.	<u>INTERMENTS</u> (excluding all charges for labour)	
A)	In graves, for any interment of the body of:-	
	a) a stillborn child, or a person whose age at the time of death did not exceed one month	No charge
	b) a person whose age at the time of death exceeded one month but did not exceed 12 years	£55.00
	c) a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years	£300.00
	d) at a depth exceeding 5 feet – the appropriate fee for interment as specified in sub-paragraphs a), b) and c) above <b>plus</b> for each additional foot of depth and additional	£110.00
B)	For interment of cremated remains for which exclusive Right of burial has been granted	£110.00
2.	<u>EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES</u>	
	a) Exclusive Right of Burial in an earthen grave 8' x 4'	£280.00
	b) Exclusive Right of Burial of ashes in the Garden of Remembrance in a plot 2' x 2'	£140.00
	c) Exclusive Right of Burial in grave in children's Section (still-born or up to one month old)	£1.00
	d) Exclusive Right of Burial – children up to 12 years old	£40.00
3.	<u>MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND INSCRIPTIONS</u>	
A.	<u>Headstones</u>	
	a) not exceeding 4' in height	£110.00
	b) exceeding 4' in height	£140.00
B.	<u>Monuments</u>	
	<u>In the form of a Vase</u>	
	a) not exceeding an overall height of 1 foot	£60.00
	b) exceeding an overall height of 1 foot	£75.00
C.	<u>A Tablet</u>	£60.00

D. Any other monument

a)	not exceeding 1 foot in height	£60.00
b)	exceeding 1 foot in height	£110.00
c)	additional inscriptions	£60.00

**NOTE**

The fees, payments and other sums set out, apply where the person to be interred, or in respect of whom the right is granted, is or was immediately before death a parishioner or inhabitant of the Parish of Fernhurst or, in the case of a stillborn child, where either or both of the parents are so qualified either when the child was born or at the time of interment.

In all other cases, the fees and other sums will be **doubled** except for those detailed under Section 3 which will not be doubled where an exclusive right of burial has been purchased under Section 2.
