FH/12/00024/DOMNP - Miss T. Hall, 5, St. Margarets Cottages, Haslemere Road, Fernhurst, Haslemere. Single storey extensions to dwelling with internal alterations.

Mrs. Braithwaite and Mr. Smith had visited the site.

Objections had been received from two neighbours who considered that the proposed extensions were overbearing and the side porch too close to the fence to allow for maintenance. The rear extension was considered too large and too high.

It was proposed by Mrs. Braithwaite and seconded by Mr. Harding that the Parish Council recommends refusal of the application due to its overbearing nature in comparison with the neighbouring properties and has suggested to the applicant's agent that the plans are resubmitted with a considerably reduced scheme to be more sympathetic to the neighbours. Carried.

FH/11/05488/FULNP - The Cowdray Trust, Greenhill House, Vann Road, Fernhurst, Haslemere. The reuse of existing buildings as ancillary residential accommodation.

FH/11/05049/DOMNP - Mr. I. Denham, The Old Barn, 6, Fernhurst Green, Fernhurst, Haslemere. Erection of garden building (single storey) 4.5m x 5.1m instead of previously agreed garage.
